Name	Explanation
Griggs	Funeral Director, Sportsman & Entrepreneur.
	4th generation member of the pioneering firm "Thomas Griggs & Son"
Barraud	Early seed & produce merchant
Larcomb	Accountant, Architect & Civil Engineer
Richter	The second sawmill to be erected in Palmerston North was owned by three Norwegians, John Richter, Jacob Nannestad & Fritz Jenssen.

Traditional or Appropriate Māori Name


Name	Explanation
William Moffatt	The Hon Rangi Mawhete
	O.B.E. (1959) for Services to the Maori People
J (Hone) Kamariera	M.B.E. (1991) for Services to the Maori People
Te Rongorito	Ngati Raukawa cheiftainess, famous for activities as a peacemaker
Matara	The name of an early steamer that bought settlers up the river from Foxton to Palmerston North

Personal Name for Special Service

Name	Explanation
D.W.Black	Company Director – Palmerston North Mayor from 1968-71.
Bruce Turner	Named as one of the first Manawatū legends of Sport in 2007 – particularly in hockey & cricket
B.J.Broughton (Bill)	Top NZ Jockey
N.J.Kinross	C.B.E. (1992) for Services to Nursing
