

KEY INSIGHTS

- The Manawatū Agri-food sector adds \$606.6m
 GDP and 8,639 jobs to the regional economy.
- For every 1\$ in GDP generated by the core Agri-food industries, an additional \$0.64 is contributed to the Palmerston North and Manawatū District economy.
- For every person directly employed in the Agri-food industries, an additional 0.73 jobs are generated in the wider regional economy.
- The Manawatū District contributes 62% of total primary industry GDP for the region, while Palmerston North contributes 60% of Agri-food processing GDP.
- Dairy cattle farming is the largest primary industry, generating a total of \$162.7m in GDP and contributing 1,632 jobs to the regional economy.
- Meat and meat product manufacturing is the largest processing industry contributing \$82.4m in GDP and adding 1,122 jobs to the region.
