The application process

Step 1

Consult your boundary neighbours

A condition of this permit is that you consult your boundary neighbours and provide us with their signed confirmation that you've spoken to them about your plans to keep three or more dogs. You'll need to do this for each property that shares a boundary with yours.

We've created a separate form for this: Boundary neighbour confirmation form. Please download it and take it with you when you talk to your neighbours. They will need to fill it in and sign it to confirm you have consulted them, and if they have any objections to your plans.

Step 2

Completing your application

Once you've completed the previous step, please date and sign the declaration at the end of the application form and put it together with scanned copies of the boundary neighbour confirmation forms.

Then drop the forms into us at our Customer Service Centre in The Square and pay the application fee.

From there, we will be able to process your application.

Step 3

Property inspection

The final step in the application process is a property inspection. Within 10 working days of receiving your completed application, an Animal Management Officer will contact you to arrange a suitable time to inspect your property.

During the inspection you will need to provide us with proof that you possess a suitable lead and muzzle for each dog, should you need to evacuate them in an emergency.
